Laborer

Workers will perform the various physical tasks required on a construction site to complete projects on time. These tasks can range from cleaning up the site, digging trenches, building pipelines, and controlling traffic on road crews. Construction laborers also operate tools like jackhammers, various hand tools, and perform other related tasks.

Operator

Operators run various types of equipment on construction job sites such as excavators, backhoes, skid steers, rollers, loaders, etc. They operate these machines to dig, scrape, cut, move dirt, and load dump trucks. On this project, Operators will use these machines to dig trenches and to lay conduits or other pipelines.

Flagger

Flaggers must be able to stand for long periods, carry and lift equipment as needed. They must also know how to use electronic safety and traffic control devices. Good verbal communication skills are critical for providing directions and safety instructions. Familiarity with nonverbal communication methods such as hand signals, signs, and other devices is equally important. Flaggers will set up cones and maintain traffic patterns around construction sites. Strong interpersonal skills, which include the ability to greet drivers and pedestrians with a friendly outgoing manner and to interact with a diverse population, are also necessary. Flaggers should be able to conduct traffic control with little to no supervision during the course of the day.
